



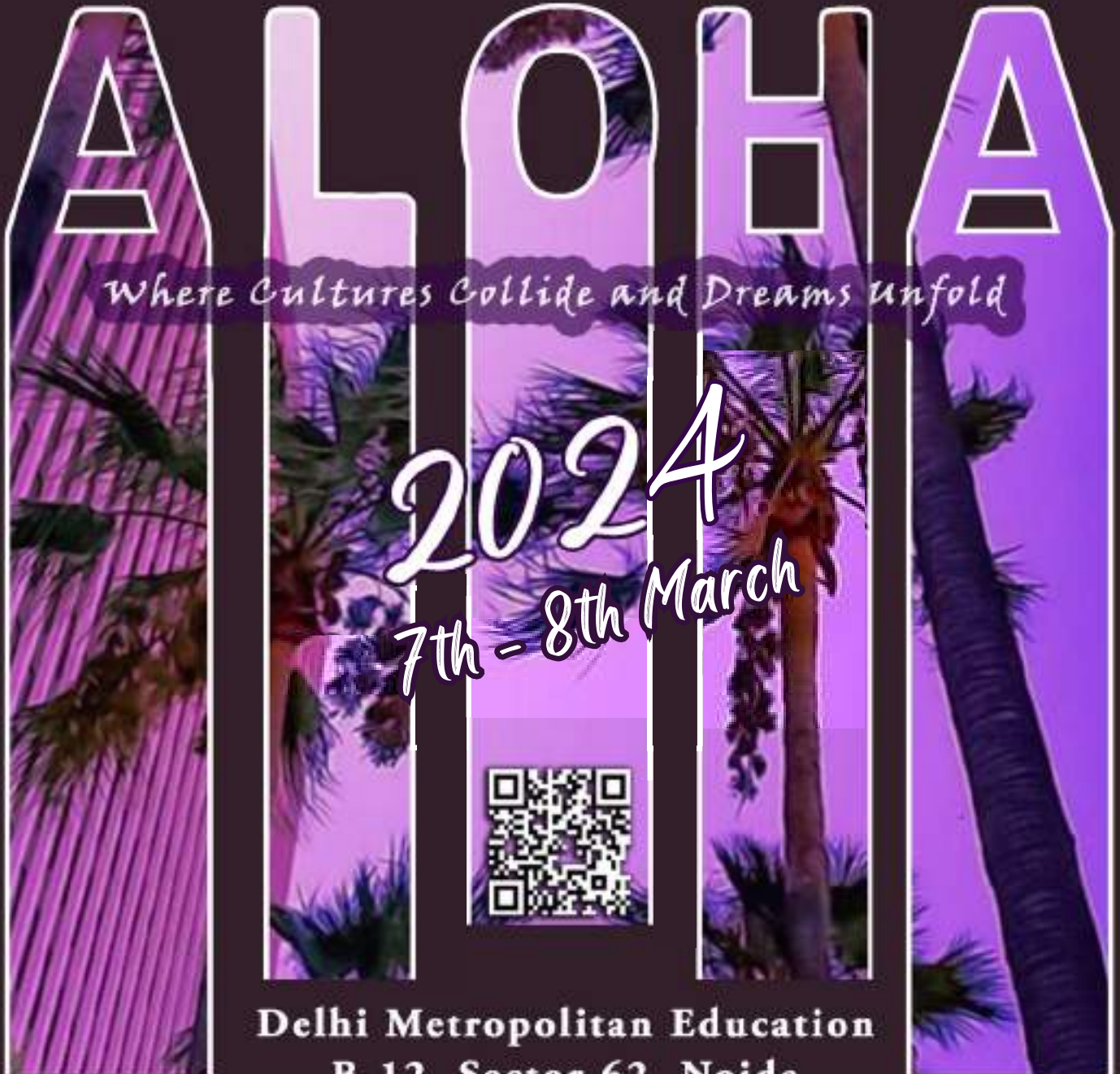

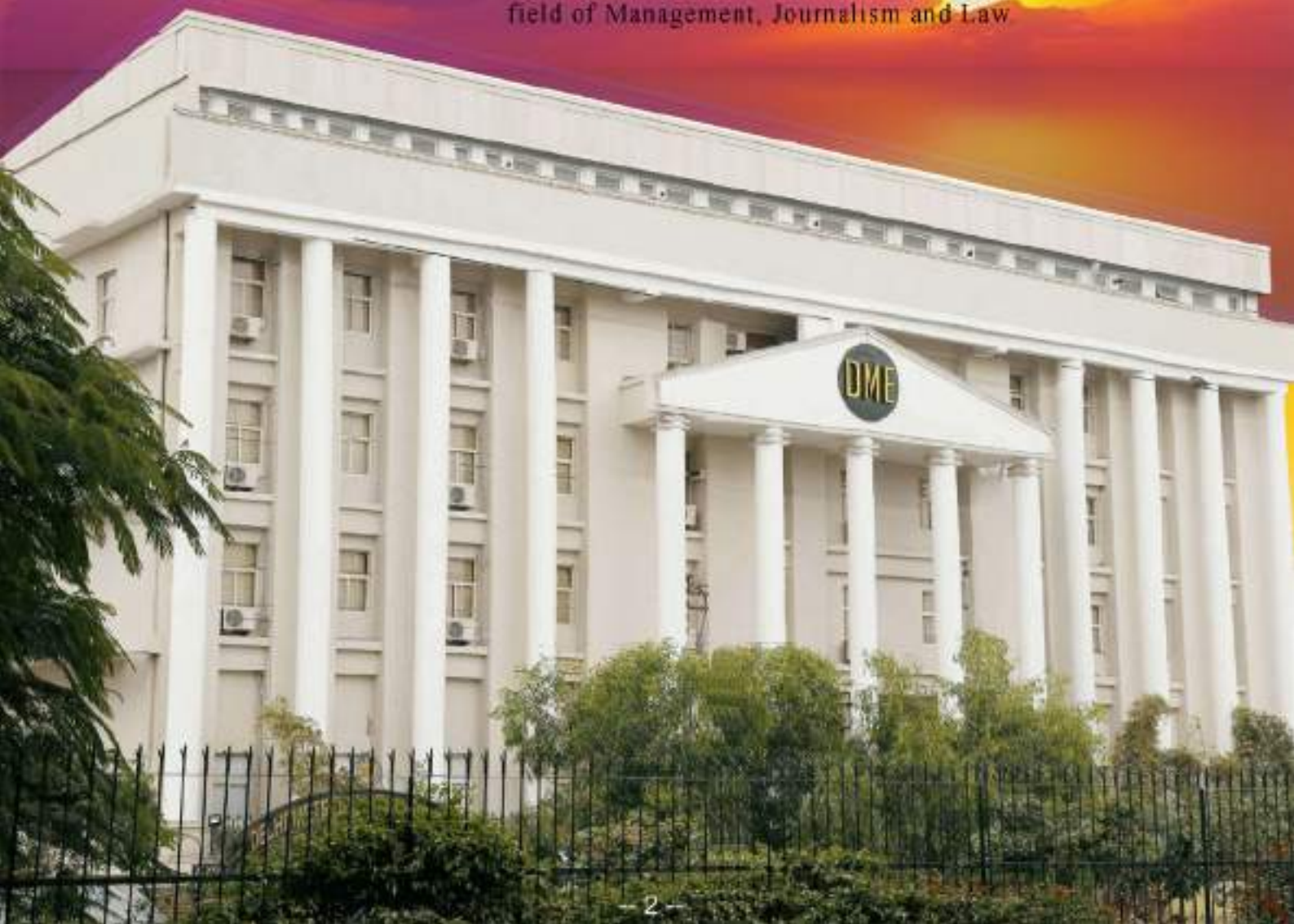

- Participants are expected to adhere to the rules and maintain good sportsmanship throughout the competition.
- The organizers reserve the right to make adjustments or clarifications to these rules as necessary for the smooth conduct of the event.
- All participants must be registered students from a college and no cross-college teams are allowed.
- A timer will be used to monitor the performance time.
- The judging panel's decisions are final.
- Any breach of the code of conduct or indiscipline by any performer may result in disqualification.
- Costumes/props/Musical instruments (if any) are to be solely arranged and brought by the participating team. The organizing committee will not take any responsibility for its safety/security.
- Adherence to the time limit is advised. Negative points for exceeding the time limit.
- There should be no instance of religious blasphemy, inappropriate content, vulgarity or usage of obscene words/phrases.
- All announcements and updates regarding the competition will be communicated to registered teams via WhatsApp group.
- It is the responsibility of each participating team to familiarize themselves with these rules and any updates or changes.
